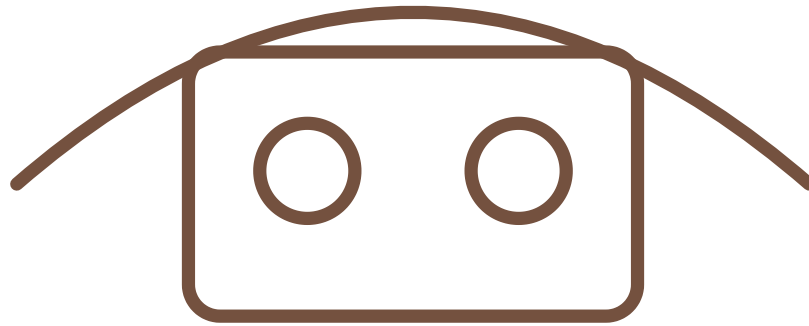

The First Thanksgiving

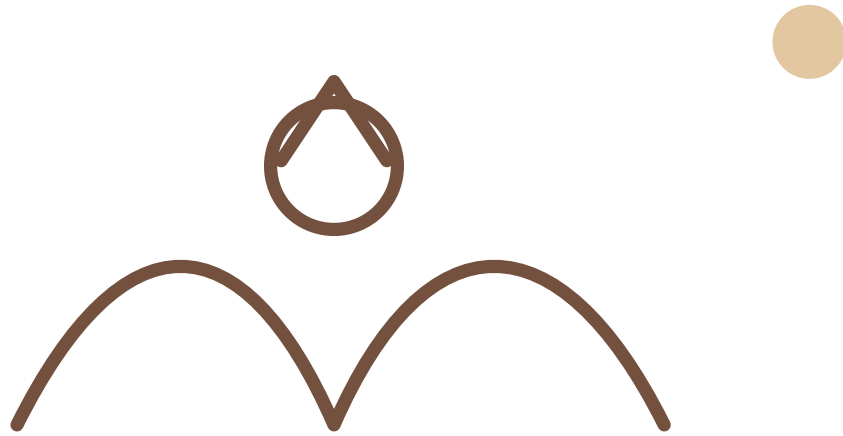

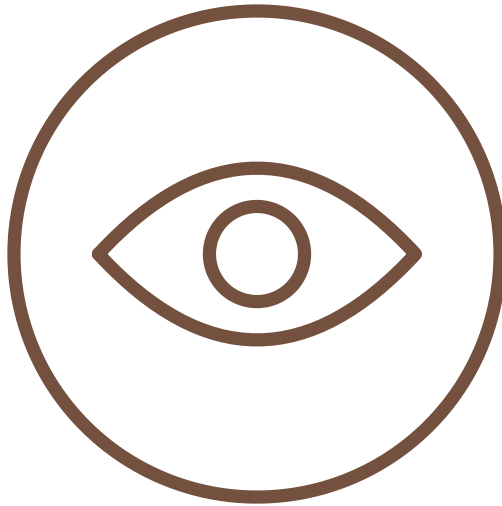
